

How to update/install the application

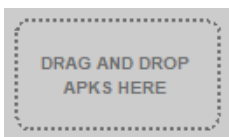

There are four ways to install the APK file to the HMT, where the first one being the easiest:

Using RWExplorer

1. If you don't have RWExplorer installed on your computer, you can download it directly from RealWear here: <https://www.realwear.com/knowledge-center/developer/rw-explorer/explorer-4-1-intro/>
2. On your computer, start RWExplorer
3. Power on and connect the HMT to your computer (use the micro-USB port on the regular HMT-1, and the USB-C port on the HMT-1-Z1).
4. On your computer, download the XMReality APK from the link above (<https://support.xmreality.com/docs/downloading-apps>)
5. On your computer, drag the Downloaded APK file into the APK drag and drop area:



and follow the on-screen instructions.

Using File Explorer

You can also install APKs without any additional tools:

1. On your computer, download the XMReality APK from the link above (<https://support.xmreality.com/docs/downloading-apps>)
2. Power on and connect the HMT to your computer (use the micro-USB port on the regular HMT-1, and the USB-C port on the HMT-1-Z1).
3. On your computer, find the HMT-1 under devices in File explorer and copy the APK onto the device.
4. On the HMT, navigate to where you copied the APK file using the glasses file browser, select the APK file, and follow the on-screen instructions.



Using RealWear Foresight

If you are managing multiple RealWear devices using RealWear Foresight, you can use the built-in deployment mechanisms in Foresight to push the APK to your devices, this is done by uploading the APK under Device Management→App Catalog and using a policy including XMReality for the intended devices.

Using ADB

For more technical users familiar with the Android Debug Bridge (ADB), installing the APK like any other using the adb install command might be the fastest option.
